# **HOW TO DISPOSE OF....**

#### (Limit 6 bags/garbage cans of trash per collection)

**ALUMINUM FOIL:** - regular trash.

**APPLIANCES:** Call 732-462-4200 option 8 then option 1 to arrange for an appliance to be picked up. If the item is picked up by the trash company, you will be billed \$70 for appliances which contain Freon (refrigerator, freezer, etc.), and \$35 if the appliance does not contain Freon (washer, dryer, etc.) Doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezers.

**ASPHALT**: Contact a recycler.

<u>BATTERIES</u>: Household batteries may be placed in the regular trash. Automotive batteries must be taken to the County Reclamation site at 6000 Asbury Avenue, Tinton Falls, N.J., tel. 732-683-8686.

**BOOKS:** Remove the pages from the books; tie in bundles up to 12 in. high and place them out with the recycling. Book covers may be placed in the regular household trash.

BRUSH COLLECTION: Residents may put their brush at the curbside during the months of April, July, & October. Brush collection does not start until the 1<sup>st</sup> of the following month and each streets brush is ONLY picked up ONE time. Residents may also drop off their brush at the DPW center at 161 Center St. the first Saturday of the month from 7a.m. – noon, tel. 732 462-3033. Brush must be cut into lengths of 4 ft. or less.

<u>BULK ITEMS</u>: Items cannot be longer than 4ft or weigh over 50lbs. Residents may place up to 2 bulk items at the curb for collection on their **second garbage pickup day of the week (Thursday or Friday)**. Mattress must be completely wrapped in plastic for pickup.

<u>CARPETING</u>: Four (4) small bundles of rolled-up carpeting may be placed in the trash on the second collection day of the week (Thursday or Friday).

**CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:** Up to 2 thirty-gallon cans of construction debris weighing no more than 60 lbs. each may be placed out for collection on the second pickup day of the week (Thursday or Friday). Does not include concrete, dirt, brick. shingles, or tiles.

**<u>DEHUMIDIFIER:</u>** - Appliance item, \$70.00 pickup fee.

**ELECTRONIC ITEMS** such as televisions, printers, computers, etc. must be recycled by taking them to the DPW site at 161 Center Street, tel. 732 462-3033. There is no charge for this service.

**FENCING:** Call a recycler

GARBAGE/HOUSEHOLD TRASH is collected twice a week. Up to 6 bags/garbage cans of trash may be placed at the curb after 6:00 p.m. on the night before the pickup day and no later than 6:30am on the scheduled pickup day. If you have any questions regarding trash collection, please call 732 462-4200 option 8 then option 1.

District 1-collection days are Monday & Thursday.

District 2-collection days are Tuesday & Friday (see schedule attached).

**GRASS CLIPPINGS:** The County recycling center will accept grass clippings for a fee of \$3.00/carload. You must schedule an appointment in advance by calling 732 683-8686, or you could use the clippings for compost.

<u>HYPODERMIC SYRINGES</u> – Please call CentraState Medical Center for assistance on disposing of syringes at 732-294-2600. There is no charge.

<u>LAWN MOWER: METAL ITEM – DRAIN ALL FLUIDS.</u> Call 732 462-4200 option 8 then option 1 to arrange for pickup.

**LEAF BLOWER: BULK ITEM, DRAIN ALL FLUIDS.** 

<u>LEAF COLLECTION</u> is conducted during the months of October, November and December, as well as in the Spring. Leaves may be raked into neat piles at the curb, or they may be placed in clear, open plastic bags for pickup. Do not combine any other branches or debris in with the leaves as it may damage the Borough's equipment.

<u>LIGHT BULBS & TUBES</u> – regular trash collection.

**MATTRESSES:** A mattress must be completely wrapped in plastic before placing it at the curb for collection on the second pickup day of the week (Thursday or Friday).

<u>MEDICATIONS</u>: prescription drugs and over the counter medications are collected each Spring by the local Police Department. Hypodermic syringes are not included in the collection. Call CentraState Medical Center for assistance at 732-294-2600.

<u>METAL ITEMS</u>: Metal items such as a **swing set, basketball hoop, barbecue grill**, etc. require a special pickup on the following Wednesday. Please call 732-462-4200 option 8 then option 1 to schedule the pickup. **No fee for the pickup**.

MICROWAVE OVEN - bulk item - place in the trash on your second collection day of the week.

**MOTOR OIL** – Call the County Recycling office for assistance at 732-683-8686.

<u>PAINT CANS</u> – Please call the County Recycling office at 732-683-8686 for assistance.

<u>PLASTIC BAGS</u> - no longer recyclable; place them in regular trash.

**PROPANE TANKS** – Please call the County Recycling office at 732-683-8686 for assistance.

**SHREDDED PAPER** – Regular trash.

**SINKS:** bulk item; place in 2<sup>nd</sup> pickup day of the week.

**SNOW BLOWER:** Bulk item; drain all fluids.

**SOFA** – bulk item; place in 2<sup>nd</sup> pickup day of the week.

**TILES**: Kitchen & bath tiles – call a recycler.

**TIRES:** Call the County Recycling office at 732-683-8686 for assistance.

<u>WATER HEATER</u> – Appliance item, \$35.00 pickup fee. Call to arrange pickup at 732-462-4200 option 8 then option 1.

WATER HEATER TANK ONLY - Call to arrange pickup at 732-462-4200 option 8 then option 1.

<u>WINDOWS</u> – Up to two (2) windows may be placed out for collection on the second pickup day of the week (Thursday or Friday).

#### **RECYCLING**

Recycling is collected every other Wednesday in the Borough.

Paper and cardboard should be tied in bundles no more than twelve (12) inches in height.

Glass, metal, and plastic items may be comingled.

Only two (2) Recycling pails are available at no charge to Borough residents by calling 732-462-3033.

Please put your address on your pail and we do not replace lost/stolen/damaged pails.

### Plastic bags are no longer recyclable as of June 2018 – regular trash.

Residents should contact a local recycler to arrange for recycling of the following items:

ASPHALT SHINGLES, CHAIN LINK & WOODEN FENCING, CONCRETE, CINDER BLOCKS, BRICKS, MOTOR OIL. KITCHEN & BATH TILES.

Please note: Trash and Recycling are NOT collected: Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day,
