

HOW DO I DISPOSE OF. . . . ?

APPLIANCES:

The pickup fee for appliances which contain Freon (refrigerator, air conditioner, etc.) is \$70.00. The fee for appliance which do not contain Freon (washer, dryer, dishwasher, hot water heater, etc.) is \$35.00. Checks should be made payable to "Borough of Freehold". Once payment has been made, the appliance pickup will be scheduled for Wednesday of the following week.

BATTERIES:

Household batteries may be placed in your regular trash. Automotive batteries must be taken to the County Reclamation site at 6000 Asbury Avenue, Tinton Falls, N.J. 07753, telephone 732 683-8686.

BRUSH COLLECTION:

Curbside brush collection takes place in the Borough during the months of March, July, and October. Brush may also be dropped off at the Public Works Yard at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month from 7:00 a.m. – noon.

BULK ITEMS:

Residents may place up to 3 bulk items (furniture, mattresses, etc.) at the curb for collection on their second trash pickup day each week (Thursday or Friday). Mattresses must be wrapped in plastic for collection.

CARPETING:

You may place up to four (4) small bundles of rolled up carpeting in your second trash collection day each week (Thursday or Friday).

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:

Up to 2 cans of construction debris may be placed out for collection on your second pickup day of the week. Each can may weigh no more than 50 lbs.

ELECTRONIC ITEMS:

Electronic items such as televisions, computers, printers, etc. must be recycled by bringing them to the Public Works yard located at 161 Center Street, tel. 732 462 3033.

GARBAGE & HOUSEHOLD TRASH:

Household trash is collected twice a week. Up to 6 bags may be placed at the curb for collection. Trash may be placed at the curb after 6 P.M. on the night before your pickup day. If the trash is not collected for any reason, please call 732 462-4200 for assistance.

GRASS CLIPPINGS:

The Monmouth County Reclamation Center located in Tinton Falls (732 683-8686) will accept grass clippings for \$3.00 per carload, and \$35.75 per truckload.

LEAF COLLECTION:

Leaf collection is conducted in the Borough during the months of October, November and December as well as in the spring,. Leaves may be raked to the curb, or they may be placed in clear, open plastic bags for pickup.

LIGHT BULBS & TUBES:

These items may be placed in your regular trash.

METAL ITEMS:

Metal items such as a swing set, treadmill or basketball hoop, etc. require a special pickup. Please call 732 462-4200 to schedule the free pickup.

PAINT CANS:

Please contact Monmouth County Recycling at 732 683 8686 for assistance.

PROPANE TANKS:

Propane tanks must be taken to the County Recycling site at 6000 Asbury Avenue in Tinton Falls (tel. 732 683-8686.).

RECYCLING PAPER, CARDBOARD, GLASS, METAL & PLASTIC:

Recycling is collected every other Wednesday in your district. Paper and cardboard should be tied in bundles no more than 12 in. high. Recycling pails for glass, metal, paper & plastic items are available at no charge by calling 732 462-4200.

RECYCLING OTHER ITEMS: Residents should contact a local recycler in order to arrange for recycling of the following items: ASPHALT SHINGLES, CHAIN LINK & WOODEN FENCING, CONCRETE CINDER BLOCKS, BRICKS, & MOTOR OIL.

TIRES:

Please contact Monmouth County Recycling at 732 747-7799 for assistance.

WINDOWS:

Up to two (2) windows may be placed out for collection on your second pickup day of the week.
