CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION 2018: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of March, July and October in 2018. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month, from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

SPRING HYDRANT FLUSHING: Spring flushing of fire hydrants will be conducted on Tuesday, April 17th, starting at 8:00 a.m. and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice a slight discoloration of the water as the flushing is conducted in their area. The discoloration is not harmful and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes. The flushing is performed twice a year in order to remove any sediment that may accumulate in the low flow areas of the water system. This flushing operation maintains the overall excellent water quality in our distribution system and ensures that each fire hydrant operates properly.

MAYOR'S CLEAN-UP DAY: Mark you calendars for the annual Mayor's Clean-up Day to be held on Saturday, May 19th, from 8 a.m.- 2 p.m. Free on-site paper shredding will be available to Borough residents only from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. at Borough Hall as part of the event.

Free paper shredding services for County residents will also be available at the Marlboro Municipal Complex on Township Dr. on March 24th, and at the Freehold Township Municipal Complex, One Municipal Plaza, on April 21st. Both events are from 9 a.m.-1 p.m.

HOUSING REHABILITATION: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. The program will provide repairs to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, and window replacement.
