FREE PAPER SHREDDING: Borough residents are encouraged to safely dispose of their unwanted papers and documents at a free, on-site paper shredding event to be held on Saturday, September 29th from 9:00 a.m.- 1:00 p.m. at Borough Hall. It is not necessary to remove paper clips, staples or rubber bands from the documents.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the month of October. Limbs should be cut into lengths of 4 ft. or less and placed at the curb for collection. Residents also have the option of taking the brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month from 7:00 a.m. to noon.
