

Genre Spotlight: Romance

One would think this is simply **books about love stories**, and one would be right--but there is so much more to the genre. While central to the romance genre is a romantic relationship, surrounding this is usually one or two of many subgenres such as suspense, mystery, paranormal, or science fiction. The storyline can be intense, a gentle read (Nicholas Sparks), or anything in-between. The passion between the main characters might be explicit (think *Fifty Shades of Grey*), chaste, or, again, somewhere in-between, depending on the author's intent. It is a genre of emotions and characters; the reader is usually pulled quickly into the story, and there is almost always a happy ending.

A recommended author is Nora Roberts as her works are often genre-crossing romantic stories featuring passionate, resourceful heroines and strong, empathetic heroes. Each story emphasizes relationships with family and friends while providing details of careers or adventure. Some recent titles include a paranormal element, but a satisfying, happy resolution remains crucial to all of her tales.
