Easy access via Freehold Public Library's webpage (www.freeholdpubliclibrary.org.)

Click Research, then JerseyClicks home page. Once the page opens, scroll halfway down and click on NoveList. (If it's your first visit, you may have to enter you library card number.)

Once you're In NoveList, search by...

- · Genre Murder, Fantasy, Romance
- Appeal various combinations you select including Style, Storyline, Illustrations, etc.
- Award Winners by age group, types of awards etc..
- · Best Reads
- "Read-Alikes" Looking for another Author similar to your favorite books? Or similar to a favorite series? Try "read-alikes" feature for a list of suggestions.

Do you work with youth? Find titles based on age, reading levels and genres.


