All across New Jersey, hundreds of towns are now working on sustainability programs to help the environment and their bottom lines. PET LICENSE RENEWALS: Pet licenses must be renewed by February 29th in order to avoid a late fee. Proof of rabies vaccinations valid through February 29th is required in order to obtain a pet license. The fee for neutered dogs is \$11.20 per year, and \$14.20 per year if the dog is not neutered. The fee for a cat license is \$10.00 a year.
