HOME REPAIR ASSISTANCE: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to meet Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. Please call Community Grants, Planning and Housing at 609-664-2769 for additional information.

PARKING PERMITS: Renewal application forms for Borough parking permits are now available at Borough Hall and online at www.freeholdboroughnj.gov. Permit fees are as follows: Commuter permits for Borough residents are \$180/year; for non-residents, the fee is \$300/year. Business parking permits are \$96/year, and daily parking permits are \$5.00/day. Please call 732 462-1410 for more information.

PET LICENSE RENEWALS: Pet licenses must be renewed by February 29th in order to avoid a late fee. Proof of rabies vaccinations valid through February 29th is required in order to obtain a pet license. The fee for neutered dogs is \$11.20 per year, and \$14.20 per year if the dog is not neutered. The fee for a cat license is \$10.00 a year.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION 2020: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of April, July and October in 2020. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month, from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

WINTER REMINDERS - SNOW ACCUMULATION AROUND FIRE HYDRANTS: A recently adopted law requires the owner of a property which abuts a fire hydrant to remove any snow which may accumulate within 24 hours of the snow coverage. Failure to remove the snow may result in a bill for snow removal service in an amount not to exceed \$75.00. Please note that the owner or tenant of a property bordering a sidewalk is responsible for the removal of all ice and snow within twelve (12) hours after it has accumulated.

DISPOSAL OF CHRISTMAS TREES: Please place discarded Christmas trees at the curb for collection during the month of January.
