BOROUGH HALL: Due to the ongoing pandemic situation, the municipal building will no longer be open for uncontrolled public access effective November 5th. Residents are urged to use the drop box located in the foyer at Borough Hall for making payments and seeking various permits. For all other business, it will be necessary to schedule an appointment with the Borough personnel you wish to meet with by calling 732 462-1410.

CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION will begin in the Borough on November 9th and will continue through December 31, 2020. Please do not include any grass clippings, limbs, branches or logs in the leaf piles as the leaves will not be collected, and you may be subject to a fine. An additional leaf collection for leaves in clear plastic bags will be held during the week of January 1st, 2021.

Residents also have the option of taking the bagged leaves to the DPW yard at 161 Center St. Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. The yard will also be open on Saturdays during November and December from 7:00 a.m. – noon. Please be sure the keep storm basins clear of leaves in front of your property.
