- Library Card Sign-Up for Freehold Borough Students Information was sent to students' homes about how to get library cards even while the library's doors are closed. With library cards, students can access ebooks, audiobooks and videos. Our goal is to have library cards in every student's "virtual" hand before summer.
- Garden Behind the Garden. Michael Zamorski, a member of Boy Scout Troop 18, has received approval to create a garden space behind the library (between the parking spaces and the Appleyard Family Reading Garden's fence) for his Eagle Scout project. Many of the materials will be reclaimed, adding to the focus of sustainability Michael has planned for the garden.

- Construction Grant Application Submitted! Based on the information we have from the State, we anticipate knowing sometime in September which of the many libraries applying will be selected. Keep your fingers crossed!
- Congratulations to the Freehold Borough Intermediate School Grant Writers Program which was recognized by the New Jersey Department of Education. The library has been chosen as beneficiary by several of the program's grant writers with projects ranging from new children's books, shelves for expanding collections, and Spanish-language material for adults, teens and children.
- Friends of the Library's "Tea Bag Letters" Fundraiser a success. Though interrupted by the state of emergency, the Friends' campaign has so far raised \$160 for gifts to the library.

We'll get back to you and walk you through the application (or help with the computer part, if you don't have access to the Internet).

And now the question everybody's asking me: *When is the library going to reopen*? As of this writing, we're working on plans, preparing the building, acquiring supplies and equipment, studying recommendations and best-practices shared by the New Jersey State Library and other library-focused entities, and paying very close attention to directives from Governor Murphy. As we move toward opening, both the Borough of Freehold, the Library Trustees and I will make the best decisions we can to protect your health and the health of library staff by reducing the spread of the SARS CoV-2 virus, while also connecting you with the resources you want and need. As they used to say, "stay tuned."

How can I get a Library Card?

If you live in Freehold Borough:

• Email <u>help@freeholdplubliclibrary.org</u> with your full-name, telephone number, grade in school (if student) and a scan/image of a bill or piece of mail sent to you (a cell-phone picture is fine). A library card will be mailed to you.

What if I don't live in Freehold Borough?

- You should contact the library that serves you based on which town you live in. For people in Freehold Township, that would be the <u>Monmouth County Library System</u>.
- The Freehold Public Library is not, during this temporary shut-down, offering membership for people residing outside of Freehold Borough. Current non-resident card-holders may have their membership extended temporarily, by request.

What Digital Resources Can I use with my Library Card?

Ebooks, downloadable audiobooks:

• <u>eLibraryNJ.com</u> (you'll need library card number and PIN) [this is otherwise known as "OverDrive"]

Download the "Libby" app for easy access via a smartphone, tablet or computer.

Videos:

• <u>Kanopy</u> and Kanopy Kids (you'll need library card number and PIN) Enjoy critically-acclaimed movies, inspiring documentaries, award-winning foreign films and more.

Databases:

- Subscription <u>Databases</u> (you'll need your library card number for most of these)
- <u>HeritageQuest</u> (contact <u>help@freeholdpubliclibrary.org</u> for access code; users must be residents of New Jersey)


Our Wi-Fi is ON!
