### NEWS & UPDATES:

- 渝COVID-19 Safety.
  - All returned material is quarantined for 3 days, so items will still be shown as "on loan" to patrons during that time. This protects staff as well as the next borrower.
  - High-touch surfaces are sanitized throughout the day (computers after each use).
  - **NEW** Visitors are limited to one hour, twice per day.
  - Mask and hand-washing/sanitizing are required.
- **Back to School.** Our local families/students as well as school administrators and faculty are working hard to start the school year off strong. Here are some library-related reminders:
  - million Visitors are limited to one hour, twice per day. Groups are not permitted to gather inside the building, including one-on-one tutoring or study groups.
  - In Online resources include <u>databases</u>, <u>ebooks</u>, <u>downloadable audiobooks</u>, and <u>videos</u>. Library cardholders must have a <u>PIN</u> to access most of these resources.
  - NEW Homework Help program will be available via Zoom for students through 6th grade. See information below.
  - finite we will be to come to the library to check out books! Our children's and YA collections are waiting for you.
  - EReference service (in other words, ask a librarian questions!) is always available via email or telephone. Students may contact the library for help with research, databases, book recommendations and random other questions.

- **Tree Grab Bags for Children!** Ask at the circulation desk for a prize bag (children ages 3 and up due to small parts).

- **Meet (via Zoom)** @ the Library. When the building was open, many groups and clubs, along with tutors and playgroups, met at the library. During our closure, we may be able to host your meeting "virtually." Contact us at help@freeholdpubliclibrary.org for more information.
- Outdoor Library Spaces are available for your use.
  - WiFi reaches areas close to the building, but there is no place to plug/recharge.
  - Please remember to keep at least six feet between people and/or wear a mask.
  - Tables/benches in the (rear) Appleyard Family Reading Garden are available on first-come, first-serve basis. If you'd like to have a picnic, bring a blanket to sit on in event the tables are being used. There's plenty of shade!
  - Remember to dispose of trash properly. There is a garbage can just outside of the gate in the rear garden, and along West Main Street out front.
  - The garden is not a dog park. Pets are permitted for only brief visits, must remain on-leash, and no pet waste may be left behind.
- Our Native New Jersey Plant Garden is almost completed. Mike Z., the Boy Scout managing the project, will be installing slate pavers for the bike parking rack and make a few other adjustments.
- New Jersey Library Construction Bond Act Grant Update: No news is...no news. We understand that information about which libraries will win the grants may now not be available until November. Fingers crossed!

Thank you for your cooperation with the necessary adjustments we've made in the library's operation in light of the pandemic. I'm reminded again how generous and gracious the people in our community are. We are inventing, together, a pathway through these unusual times.

Speaking of adjustments, when the library opened in July, the "dwell time" for visitors in the building was 30 minutes. The time limit is now increased to one hour in the morning, and one hour in the afternoon (with at least an hour break between visits). Please note that staff are not authorized to make exceptions to this policy.


As of this writing, we don't know when we'll return to our prior schedule (Saturdays and evenings) for access to the library building. All of our programs are offered online; many of those are in the evening.
