BRUSH AND LEAF COLLECTION: Brush collection is complete. The Borough will collect brush again in April 2024. Leaf collection is underway and only available annually during November and December. Residents also have the option of taking their brush and leaves to the Public Works site located at 161 Center St. every Saturday from 7 a.m. to noon during the months of November and December. Leaves must be placed in clear plastic bags or brown biodegradable bags. The site is also open on the first Saturday of each month from 7 a.m. - noon from January through October.



RECYCLE COACH APP AVAILABLE: Recycle Coach was implemented in 2018. Residents are encouraged to download the "Recycle Coach" app to reduce the amount of household waste and become more efficient recyclers. The free app may be downloaded at the iTunes Store and Google Play. With Recycle Coach, residents may stay organized with curbside collection & event calendars, as well as receive reminders and notices regarding service disruptions. Residents will also have access to a problem-reporting tool to notify municipal officials of any problems or concerns.

FREE FIREWOOD HARVESTING PROGRAM: The Lake Topanemus Commission is currently hosting a free Firewood Harvesting Program at the lake for homeowners to obtain free firewood while supporting maintenance of the park and promoting healthy outdoor activities. Applicants must provide their own equipment to cut and transport the firewood. UPDATE - Borough of Freehold Resident Communications - Everbridge STAY Get alerted about emergencies, important community news, and local events by signing up for our INFORMED! Everbridge Notification Program.

This notification system enables your municipality to provide you with critical information quickly in a variety of situations, such as severe weather, unexpected road closures, missing persons, and evacuation of buildings or neighborhoods. You will receive the critical messages wherever you specify, such as your home, cell, or business phone, email, text messages, hearing impaired receiving devices, and more. You pick where, you pick how you would like to receive the critical messages. This notification system offers you to be informed with the happenings in community via email only.
