EASTER BUNNY EVENT: The Freehold Borough Recreation Commission is hosting a socially – distance meet & greet with the Easter Bunny. Stop by the front of the Freehold Fire House on **Saturday, April 1, 2023 from 11am – 1pm** to say "Hil" and take your own picture with the Easter Bunny! Each Child will receive a free goody bag courtesy of the Freehold Borough Recreation Commission. (One per child and child must be present. For the first 250 children.) This is a FREE event.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION will take place in the Borough during the months of **April, July and October**. The DPW site at 161 Center St. is open for brush collection on the first Saturday of the month from 7:00 a.m.- noon. **DOES NOT include LEAVES** which are able to be dropped off to the DPW site during November and December along with curbside pickup. Please call the **COUNTY** recycling at 732-683-8686 to schedule an appointment to dispose of your **GRASS CLIPPINGS**.

SPRING HYDRANT FLUSHING: Spring flushing of fire hydrants in the Borough will be conducted on **TUESDAY, APRIL 18TH starting at 8:00 a.m.** and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice a slight discoloration of the water as the flushing is conducted in their area. The discoloration is not harmful and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes. This flushing operation maintains the overall excellent water quality in our distribution system and ensures that each fire hydrant operates properly.



HOME REPAIR ASSISTANCE: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to meet Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties, which are occupied by low and moderate-income persons. Get alerted about emergencies, important community news, and local events by signing up for our Everbridge Notification Program. This notification system enables your municipality to provide you with critical information quickly in a variety of situations, such as severe weather, unexpected road closures, missing persons, and evacuation of buildings or neighborhoods. You will receive the critical messages wherever you specify, such as your home, cell, or business phone, email, text messages, hearing impaired receiving devices, and more. You pick where, you pick how you would like to receive the critical messages. This notification system offers you to be informed with the happenings in community via email only.
