This year, we're observing National Library Week in our temporary quarters at the Freehold Borough Municipal Building. We can hardly wait to begin serving our community in our "old and improved" library facility on East Main Street!

According to the Center for Disease Control, approximately 11.1% of the population lives with a serious mobility impairment (<u>link to source</u>). According to the latest census figures, Freehold Borough's population is 12,532 (<u>link to source</u>). This means that roughly 1,500 of our neighbors will soon be able to more fully enjoy their community library.

By the same census information, I calculate that there are approximately 650 children under the age of five in our town. Having raised four children here, I

remember the hassle of getting in and out of the library with a baby stroller. And if a diaper change was needed? Well, that

meant the abrupt end of that day's library visit! We'll soon have convenient and safe access for families pushing strollers; sanitary facilities for diaper changing; child-sized furniture; and age-and need-appropriate spaces for everyone to enjoy the library.


Eyes on the prize!
