

What is Healthy Hop?

Healthy Hop is a <u>free transportation service</u> in Monmouth County, NJ designed to help seniors aged 60 years and older get to their medical appointments without any stress or worry.

We understand that many seniors have difficulty accessing reliable transportation, which is why we have partnered with the Monmouth County Office on Aging to provide this service.

With our service, seniors can simply call us when they are ready for a medical appointment, and we will arrange for an Uber, Lyft, or local taxi service to pick them up. No need to book ahead or worry about transportation logistics. We'll take care of everything for you!

To use our service, seniors must register by filling out a brief application. This ensures that we have all the necessary information to provide a safe and efficient transport.
