

**NEW WATER METER PROGRAM:** The Mayor and Council have contracted with Saks Metering to conduct an area-wide mandatory water meter upgrade project. Saks' authorized installers will be working in the Borough with company uniforms, car signs, and photo ID. All installers have undergone N.J. State background checks. Typically, the upgrade should take no more than an hour. Your water meter is most likely located inside your home, basement, or crawl space. Very soon, you will be notified by the installer, Saks, with instructions on how to make an appointment for the installation of your new meter. You will be notified via a letter, emails, and a door hanger. Continue to check the Borough website for updates. If you have any questions, please call 732 462-4200.

**BRUSH COLLECTION:** Curbside brush collection is currently underway in the Borough during the month of July. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Any brush left at the curb after July 31<sup>st</sup> may result in a violation notice. Encourage your neighbors and friends to take advantage of this July brush collection as the next curbside pickup will not take place until October.

**ATTENTION SWIMMING POOL & HOT TUB OWNERS:** The Uniform Construction Code of the State of New Jersey states that construction permits are required for any structure intended for swimming or recreational bathing that can hold water 24 inches or more in depth. This includes in-ground, above-ground, on-ground, and children's inflatable pools, as well as hot tubs and spas. Please contact the Code Office at 732 462-4903 for more information.
