

IMPORTANT REMINDER: SAK'S Metering, the company hired by Freehold Borough to install mandatory new water meters, is nearing the completion of their work. At some point in the very near future, Freehold Borough will not be able to supply water to a property unless the new water meter has been installed. The deadline for the installation of the new meter is March 1, 2017.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION 2017: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of April, July and October in 2017. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month, from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

PET LICENSE RENEWALS: Applications for the renewal of pet licenses in the Borough are now due. Proof of rabies vaccination through October 31, 2017 must be provided in order to obtain a license. The fee for neutered dogs is \$11.20, and \$14.20 for dogs which are not neutered. Cat licenses are \$10.00.

HOUSING REHABILITATION: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. The program will provide repairs to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, and window replacement.
