SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM: Freehold Borough will be undertaking its Sidewalk Improvement Program during the Spring and Summer of 2018 in order to help residents correct code deficiencies that result from tree roots, normal decay, and other unsafe conditions. The Borough will pay one-half of the cost of the sidewalks. Repairs are limited to deficiencies only, and residents will be included on a first-come, first-served basis. The deadline for participation is March 1st, 2018. Please call 732 462-4200 for additional information.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION 2018: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of March, July and October in 2018. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month, from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

HOUSING REHABILITATION: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. The program will provide repairs to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, and window replacement. PET LICENSE RENEWALS: Pet licenses must be renewed by February 28th, 2018 in order to avoid late charges. Proof of rabies vaccinations valid through October 31, 2018 must be provided in order to obtain a license. The fee for neutered dogs is \$11.20; \$14.20 if the dog is not neutered. The fee for a cat license is \$10.00.

COMMUNITY GARDEN: The Community Garden, located on Lloyd St., invites residents to come join them in growing their own herbs and vegetables, as well as produce that is donated to local food banks.
