FALL HYDRANT FLUSHING: Fall flushing of fire hydrants will be conducted on Wednesday, October 14, 2020, starting at 8:00 a.m. and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice lower water pressure and slight discoloration of the water as the flushing is performed in your area. The discoloration is not harmful, and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes. The flushing process maintains the overall excellent water quality in our distribution system and ensures that each fire hydrant operates properly.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION will take place in the Borough during the month of October. All brush must be cut into lengths of 4 ft. or less and placed at the curb for pickup. Leaves should be piled at the curb in separate piles from the brush. Please be sure the brush and leaves do not interfere with any storm drains in your area. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the DPW site located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month from 7:00 a.m. - noon.

BOROUGH HALL: Borough Hall is open for in-person business Monday through Friday, from 1:00 - 4:00 p.m. One person per family will be permitted to enter, and access to the building will be limited to 3 persons at a time. Face coverings must be worn. The public is strongly encouraged to continue to conduct business with the Borough through the drop box in the foyer and by phone (732 462-1410) and online at www.freeholdboroughnj.gov.

FLU SHOTS The Freehold Area Health Department will have flu shots available for Borough residents over the age of 18 yrs. at Borough Hall, 51 West Main St., Freehold on Tuesday, October 6th from 1:00-2:00 p.m. The cost is \$20, and the shots are free for senior citizens who present their Medicare card.
