**CURBSIDE BRUSH/LEAF COLLECTION:** Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of April, July and October in 2021. Brush will be collected on each street twice during the month of April. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Leaves may also be placed at the curb for collection during the month of April, provided they are separated from the brush in a separate pile. Please note that any resident who places brush and/or leaves at the curb for pickup, outside the months of April, July and October, will be subject to a fine.

Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the DPW site located at 161 Center Street, Freehold, on the first Saturday of each month from 7:00 a.m. – noon.

**COVID-19 VACCINE:** Registration for the Covid-19 vaccine is held every Tuesday from 1 – 7 p.m., and on Thursdays from 9 a.m.- 4 p.m. at the fire house, 49 West Main St. for those who are eligible to receive the vaccine. Please call 732 462-1410 for more information.

**MAYOR'S CLEANUP DAY:** Mark your calendars for the Mayor's Clean-up Day to be held on Saturday, May 22, from 8 a.m.- 2 p.m. Residents may place 5 bulk items out for collection on each of their pickup days during the week of May 17. On May 22nd, additional dumpsters will be available at the Park Avenue School (280 Park Ave.) and the DPW site (161 Center St) from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Also on May 22, Borough residents will have an opportunity to safely dispose of their unwanted papers and documents at free on-site paper shredding at Borough Hall from 8:00 a.m. – noon, or until the truck is filled.

**BOROUGH WIDE YARD SALE:** The Recreation Commission will host their Borough Wide Yard Sale on Saturday, May 15 (raindate May 16), from 9 a.m.- 2 p.m. The yard sales are held at each participant's home, and shoppers' maps listing the location of the sale and items being sold at that location will be available.
