

BANNARD STREET ROAD CONSTRUCTION TO START MONDAY, MARCH 9TH

Sea Coast Construction will begin road construction on Bannard Street on Monday morning, March 9th (weather permitting). The work will include the installation of new curbs and driveway aprons, followed by milling and resurfacing of the roadway. Representatives from Sea Coast Construction will notify residents and businesses in the area regarding traffic flow, parking and delivery issues while the work is underway.

It is anticipated the roadwork will be completed in 5 – 6 weeks, depending on weather conditions. The work will begin on Bowne Ave, and head to Stokes Street, on the residential side of the street (approximately 2 weeks). Work will then begin on the other side of the street and should be completed in about 2 weeks.

PLEASE NOTE: RESIDENTS WILL NOT HAVE ACCESS TO THEIR DRIVEWAYS FOR A FULL FOUR (4) DAYS AFTER THE DRIVEWAY APRONS HAVE BEEN POURED.

Residents are asked to park on the commercial side of the street while work is underway on the residential side. The opposite will apply while work is underway on the other side of the street.

General sidewalk replacement is not included in the work plan.

The area between the sidewalk and the curb will be planted with sod when the work is completed.

Each resident will have their driveway apron and the sidewalk area that meets the driveway replaced as part of the project.
