

PROPERTY REVALUATION PROGRAM

The Monmouth County Board of Taxation recently ordered a complete revaluation of all properties to become effective in tax year 2017. The revaluation is performed in order to determine the current value of the property, and to ensure a fair and equitable distribution of the tax burden among all property owners.

The Borough has contracted with Realty Appraisal Company to perform the revaluations. The work will begin in a few weeks. A complete inspection of the interior and exterior of each building on your property will be performed. The exterior of each property will also be photographed and measured.

Each representative of Realty Appraisal will be furnished with a letter of identification signed by our tax assessor, Mitch Elias, and a form of photo identification. Please do not permit anyone access to your property unless they present the proper identification. All inspectors have undergone background checks by the Freehold Police Department.
