RECYCLE COACH IS NOW AVAILABLE! Freehold Borough is pleased to announce the "Recycle Coach" app is now available for Borough residents who wish to reduce the amount of their household waste and also become more efficient recyclers. The free app may be downloaded at the iTunes Store and Google Play. With Recycle Coach, residents may stay organized with curbside collection & event calendars, as well as receive reminders and notices regarding service disruptions. Residents will also have access to a problem-reporting tool to notify municipal officials of any problems or concerns they may have.

POOL FILLS: Any resident wishing to fill a swimming pool should schedule a water meter reading before and after filling the pool. In that way, a credit can be issued on the next water bill for the water which did not enter into the sewer system. This includes in-ground, above-ground, and on-ground swimming pools.
