CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will take place in Freehold Borough during the month of October. Limbs and branches must be cut into lengths of 4 ft. or less for pickup. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month, from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

LEAF COLLECTION: Curbside leaf pick-up will commence in the Borough on Thursday, November 1st, and will continue until all leaves have been collected. Leaves may be left in loose piles at the curb, or you may place them in clear plastic bags at the curb.
