## **Notables for July**

- July was originally the month of Quintilis in the Roman calendar. It was the fifth month of the year until January and February were added in 450 BC. It got its original name from the Latin word for fifth. Later the name was changed to Julius in honor of Julius Caesar who was born on July 12.
- · Independence Day, also referred to as the Fourth of July or July Fourth, is a federal holiday in the United States commemorating the adoption of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776. The Continental Congress declared that the thirteen American colonies regarded themselves as a new nation, the United States of America, and were no longer part of the British Empire.
- International Joke Day ~ July 1
- U.S. postage stamps went on sale for the first time (1847).
- Dick Clark hosts American Bandstand for the very first time (1956).
- · Etch-a-Sketch goes on sale (1960).
- In "one small step for man, one giant step for mankind," astronaut Neil Armstrong becomes the first person to walk on the moon (1969).

- August is named after Augustus Caesar, founder and the first emperor of the Roman Empire, who was posthumously adopted by his maternal great-uncle Gaius Julius Caesar.
- · August 1 traditionally marked the beginning of the serious harvest. "After Lammas Day, corn ripens as much by night as by day."
- Siyali Ramamrita Ranganathan (August 9, 1892 1972) was a mathematician and librarian from India. His most notable contributions to the field were his five laws of library science and the development of the first major faceted classification system, the colon classification. He is considered to be the father of library science, documentation, and information science in India and is widely known throughout the rest of the world for his fundamental thinking in the field.
