**MAYOR'S CLEAN-UP DAY:** Mark you calendars for the 8th Annual Mayor's Clean-up Day to be held on Saturday, May 18th, from 8 a.m.- 2 p.m. On that day, Borough residents will have an opportunity to safely dispose of their unwanted papers and documents at free on-site paper shredding at Borough Hall from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. It is not necessary to remove staples or paperclips from your documents.

**CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION 2019:** Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of March, July and October in 2019. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Residents also have the option of taking their brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month, from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

**FREE RADON KITS:** Radon test kits are now available for Borough residents at Borough Hall, 51 W. Main St. There is no charge for these kits, but proof of residency is required. For more information, please call the Borough Clerk's office at 732 462-1259.

**HOUSING REHABILITATION:** Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. The program will provide repairs to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, and window replacement. **WINTER REMINDERS:** A recently adopted law requires the owner of a property which abuts a fire hydrant to remove any snow within 2 ft. of the hydrant which may accumulate within 24 hours of the snow coverage. Failure to remove the snow may result in a bill for snow removal services in an amount not to exceed \$75.00. Please note that the owner or tenant of a property bordering a sidewalk is responsible for the removal of all ice and snow within twelve (12) hours after it has accumulated
