PARKING PERMITS: Parking permits for businesses and commuters expired on December 31, 2018. Renewal applications are available at Borough Hall, 51 West Main St., Freehold, and online at www.freeholdboroughnj.gov. A daily parking pass for one day is also available for \$5.00. Please call 732 462-1410 for more information. Business permits will be issued on a quarterly basis at \$24.00 per quarter. The first quarter runs from January 1, 2019 - March 31, 2019. Second quarter permits will be available the last two weeks of March, and will run from April 1, 2019 - June 30, 2019. There is no change in the commuter fee of \$180 for a resident, and \$300 for a non-resident on an annual basis.

PET LICENSE RENEWALS: Applications for pet license renewals will be mailed out during January. Proof of rabies vaccinations through October 31, 2019 must be provided in order to obtain a license. The fee for neutered dogs is \$11.20; \$14.20 if the dog is not neutered. Cat licenses are \$10.00, and late charges will be applied after February 29, 2019.

FREE RABIES CLINIC: The Freehold Health Department will host a free rabies clinic for area residents on Saturday, January 26th from 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. at the fire house located at 49 West Main St. Dogs must be leashed, and cats must be in carriers.

WATER & SEWER EMERGENCIES: Water & Sewer Dept. personnel are available 7 days a week, 24 hrs. a day to respond to any water/sewer emergencies. It is important to contact the Borough before calling a plumber in order to determine who is responsible to make the repairs. During regular business hours, please call 732 462-4200; at all other times, please call the police department at 732 462-1233 for assistance.

HOME REPAIR ASSISTANCE: The Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income households. Please call 609 371-1937 for more information.

WINTER REMINDERS: A recently adopted law requires the owner of a property which abuts a fire hydrant to remove any snow which may accumulate within 24 hours of the snow coverage. Failure to remove the snow may result in a bill for snow removal services in an amount not to exceed \$75.00. Please note that the owner or tenant of a property bordering a sidewalk is responsible for the removal of all ice and snow within twelve (12) hours after it has accumulated.
