FREEHOLD CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION: Freehold Borough was incorporated just 100 years ago when it separated from Freehold Township and became it's own municipality. Enjoy the Borough's Centennial Celebration with events all year long, including Olde Freehold Day on August 17th and a Centennial Gala at the American Hotel on September 6th.

BOROUGH-WIDE YARD SALE: The Freehold Borough Recreation Commission will host their 12th Annual Borough-Wide Yard Sale on Saturday, September 28th (raindate September 29th) from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Each year, over 100+ families host individual yard sales at their homes. Application forms are available online at www.freeholdboroughnj.gov, or by calling the Recreation Commission at 732 462-4200. A permit is not required for this sale.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will only take place in the Borough during the month of July. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Please do not include any leaves or grass clippings in with the brush. Residents may also take their brush to the DPW site located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month from 7:00 a.m. – noon.

SHADE TREES: Shade trees in the Borough which are planted between the sidewalk and the curb are the property of the Borough. If one of the trees are in need of attention, please notify Borough Hall at 732 462-4200. The Borough will examine the tree and determine what action should be taken. Residents are reminded not to do any work on Borough trees on their own.

OLDE FREEHOLD DAY: Once again the popular Olde Freehold Day will return to Lake Topanemus on Saturday, August 17th from noon – 6:00 p.m. The day will feature boating on the lake, a Kidz Zone, contests, games and crafts, live music, a car smash, food vendors and more. Admission is free.

RABIES CLINIC: The Freehold Health Department will host a free rabies clinic for area residents on Thursday, September 12th from 6:00-7:00 p.m. at the fire house located at 49 West Main Street. Dogs must be leashed, and cats must be in carriers.

HOUSING REHABILITATION: The Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to bring it up to Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties which are occupied by low and moderate income persons. Repairs will be provided to major systems such as roofing, heating, electric, foundation repairs, etc. Please contact Community Grants, Planning & Housing at 609 664-2781 for details.
