FALL HYDRANT FLUSHING: Fall flushing of fire hydrants will be conducted on Wednesday, October 16, 2019 starting at 8:00 a.m. and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice lower water pressure and slight discoloration of the water as the flushing is performed in your area. The discoloration is not harmful, and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes. The flushing process maintains the overall excellent water quality in our distribution system and ensures that each fire hydrant operates properly.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the month of October. Limbs should be cut into lengths of 4 ft. or less and placed at the curb for collection. Residents also have the option of taking the brush to the public works yard located at 161 Center St. on the first Saturday of each month from 7:00 a.m. to noon.

FREE PAPER SHREDDING: Borough residents are encouraged to safely dispose of their unwanted papers and documents at a free, on-site paper shredding event to be held on Saturday, September 28th from 9:00 a.m.- 1:00 p.m. at Borough Hall. It is not necessary to remove paper clips, staples or rubber bands from the documents.

FLU SHOT CLINIC: The Freehold Area Health Department will host a flu shot clinic for Borough residents 18 yrs. of age and older on Tuesday, October 8th from 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. at Borough Hall, 51 W.
