

**Liberty Street Park** - Freehold Borough Liberty Street at 3rd Avenue. Basketball courts, baseball field, picnic area, playground, paved trails.

**Veterans Memorial Park** - Freehold Borough 41 Schanck Street. Recently refurbished with playground, pavilion.

Freehold Borough Little League Fields -Freehold Borough. 54 Otterson Road. Playground nestled among baseball fields.

**Henry Hudson Trail** - Freehold Borough (southern end of trail). Paved "rail trail" for walking, running or bicycling.

**East Freehold Showgrounds** - Freehold Township. 1500 Kozloski Road. Open green space. Home of the Monmouth County Fair.

**Lake Topanemus Park** - Freehold Township. Pond Road. Trails, lake (fishing/boating), playground, picnic area.

**Turkey Swamp Park** - Freehold Township. 200 Georgia Road. Sprawling park with playground, picnic areas, archery range, lake (fishing/boating), hiking trails.

Monmouth Battlefield State Park - Manalapan. 16 Business Route 33. Museum, playground, large area for sledding and hiking trails.

**Michael J. Tighe Park** - Freehold Township. 65 Georgia Road. Sports fields, playgrounds, hiking trails.
