Pick-up your bag of books at the front entrance of the library, or telephone us when you're out front on Main Street and we'll bring your order to your car. Two parking spaces in front of the library have been reserved for patrons to pick-up and drop-off material while the library remains closed to the public.

- COVID-19 Safety. All returned material are quarantined for 3 days, so items will still be shown as "on loan" to patrons during that time. This protects staff as well as the next borrower.

- When Will the Library Open? We don't know yet. We're watching the guidance, preparing the building, and making operational changes to keep our community safe.

• Garden Behind the Garden. Michael Zamorski, a member of Boy Scout Troop 18, has made a great deal of progress on the indiginous plants teaching garden in the space behind the library (between the parking spaces and the Appleyard Family Reading Garden's fence). This is Michael's Eagle Scout project. The existing bicycle parking dock is more accessible, the bench reinstalled, a new garbage can, and beautiful plants native to New Jersey complete the new garden. There's still work to be done, but already the area is much improved!

Michael will make educational materials available detailing the characteristics of the plants selected. In addition to Michael's Boy Scout helpers, Tim at Home Depot, Ed Franczak at Ciccone Nursery, Joe Floudas and crew at Freehold Borough have share their time, material, expertise or hard work (and the American Hotel for providing water for the thirsty young plants!).

Dear Library Patron:

As of July 1, we don't have a firm date on when the library will be open to the public. I can share with you some of the changes we've put in place to make your library experience as safe as possible during these times.

- Library operating hours will continue **Monday through Friday, 9am 5pm** until further notice.
- Enter building at front (East Main Street) entrance only. Exit via front or side.
- All patrons must wear a cloth mask covering nose and mouth.
- Anyone exhibiting signs of possible illness will be denied entry.
- Physical distance of six feet (or barrier) must be maintained between non-cohabitants (family members).
- Occupancy of building will be capped at 14 visitors (25% of normal occupancy).
- Thirty minute time limit per visit; lounging/lingering discouraged.
- Computer use limited to 30 minutes; patrons must wash hands prior to use.
- If indicated, traffic control measures may be instituted ("one in, one out" or time-stamped tickets issued). Total visits per person per day may be limited.
- Some areas of the library will be open by patron request only (including Children's Room).
- Consumption of food and beverages prohibited.
- No meetings/groups permitted (including one-on-one tutoring, counseling, interviewing, etc.) inside building.
- Masks and/or six feet of separation must be observed on library property outside of building.
- No one-on-one (close proimity) computer assistance available.
- Fax, scan, and printing services will resume. Cash, small bills/exact change only, please. Free Notary service available (call for an appointment).

To protect you and the staff:

- Quarantining of returned items will continue (items will still be listed as "checked out" to you during that time, but no late fees will be charged).
- All high-touch surfaces will be frequently sanitized (computers between each use).
- Hand sanitizer is available at entrance; frequent hand-washing encouraged.
- "Curbside" service will remain an option.
- "Sneeze guards" have been installed at Circulation Desk, between computers, and at most tables.
- Outside air exchange on main level improved.
- Interior door at entrance propped-open to reduce touch points.
- Any "on-sight" library programs will be held outdoors. "Virtual" programs will continue using Zoom.
- Late fees will not be changed until further notice. Please be courteous to other patrons and return material in a timely fashion.
- Side door designated "exit only" to reduce challenges to physical distancing at ramp/door/stair area.
- Doorbells installed to call for help at both front and side doors.

- "Community Board" moved to online format to reduce congestion in vestibule.
- At the discretion of staff/director, any library visitor who fails to comply with measures instituted for the safety and comfort of staff or other visitors will be excluded from the premises.

We look forward to welcoming you back into your library home as soon as possible.


