October is National Book Month. Organized by the [National Book Foundation](#) (whose mission is “to celebrate the best literature in America, expand its audience, and ensure that books have a prominent place in American culture”), National Book Month gives people who love to read just another excuse to indulge in the excitement surrounding literature and authors.

You probably already believe that many people who obviously **know how to read** don’t read **books**. One [survey](#) shows that fewer people reported reading books in the United States in 2019 than in 2011.



This isn’t to suggest that shorter reading has less value. Your library supports reading of any duration (magazines, newspapers, online articles, etc.). [And not just reading. Though traditionally considered “a place to get books,” modern libraries are fundamentally about unrestricted access to material of the consumer’s choice and quality/accuracy of information via any format.]




But consider this: books aren’t just about **reading**. They provoke a sense of immersion, a deeper relationship with a subject, and may even temporarily alter the reader’s state of mind. Picking up a book may feel like a commitment because books require more *time* and *attention*. Maybe that’s why books can feel so daunting--there are so many demands on our time and attention already. But “you get what you pay for.” Reading longer works brings a different set of rewards than “quick reads.”

If you haven’t sunk your teeth into a longer read (a book) in a while, perhaps National Book Month can be your excuse to give it a go. Pick something--anything--you’re interested in. The library staff will be happy to help you select from our shelves or our ebook collection (OverDrive/Libby).
