SPRING HYDRANT FLUSHING: Spring flushing of fire hydrants in the Borough will be conducted on TUESDAY, APRIL 13TH starting at 8:00 a.m. and continuing until all flushing has been completed. Residents may notice a slight discoloration of the water as the flushing is conducted in their area. The discoloration is not harmful and will clear up if you allow the water to run for a few extra minutes. This flushing operation maintains the overall excellent water quality in our distribution system and ensures that each fire hydrant operates properly.

COVID 19 VACCINE: The New Jersey Covid19 Call Center is now open to assist residents who do not have access to a computer to make an appointment to receive the Coronavirus vaccine. The toll-free number is 1-855-568-0545.

LIBRARY RE-OPENS: The Freehold Public Library located at $28^{1}/2$ East Main Street has re-opened to the public as follows: Monday & Wednedays from 9 a.m.- 9.p.m., and from 9 a.m.- 5 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. FREE RABIES CLINIC: The Freehold Borough Health Department will host a free rabies clinic on Saturday, March 20th, from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. at the fire house located at 49 West Main St. Pets must be at least 3 months old. Cats must be in carriers, and dogs must be leashed.

PAPER SHREDDING: Monmouth County will host a free paper shredding event for County residents at the Park Avenue School, 280 Park Ave., Freehold, N.J. on Sunday, June 27th from 9 a.m.- 1:00 p.m., or until the truck is filled. Staples and paper clips may remain in place, but large binder clips must be removed from your documents. This program is for residents only; no businesses will be allowed to participate.

CURBSIDE BRUSH/LEAF COLLECTION: Curbside brush collection will take place in the Borough during the months of April, July and October in 2021. Limbs should be no longer than 4 ft. in length. Leaves may also be placed at the curb for collection in a separate pile from the brush.
