BRUSH AND LEAF COLLECTION: Brush collection is complete. The Borough will collect brush again in April 2022. Leaf collection is underway and will continue through December 31, 2021.

Residents also have the option of taking their brush and leaves to the Public Works site located at 161 Center St. every Saturday from 7 a.m. to noon during the months of November and December. Leaves must be placed in clear plastic bags or brown bio-degradable bags. The site is also open on the first Saturday of each month from 7 a.m. – noon from January through October.

NEW BOROUGH HALL: Borough Hall recently moved to our new location at 30 Mechanic Street. Office hours and all telephone numbers remain unchanged. Masks are required in order to enter the building.

HOLIDAY HOUSE DECORATING CONTEST: Once again, the Freehold Borough Recreation Commission will host their annual House Decorating Contest. Residents are invited to contact the Commission at 732 462-4200 by December 10th to register for the contest. Houses will be judged on Monday, December 13th starting at 5:30 p.m. An award ceremony will be held on December 17th at 5:30 p.m. at the Hall of Records on East Street.

HOLIDAY TRASH COLLECTION: There will be no trash collection on Thanksgiving Day, November 25, 2021.

HOLIDAY CANCELLATIONS: The annual Seniors' Holiday Party and the Fire Department's "Operation Santa" are cancelled this year due to Covid concerns.
