What makes a writer?

In my opinion, it's simply someone who writes!

The **Come Write In!** group at Freehold Public Library started I-don't-remember-how-many-years-ago as a



<u>National Novel Writing Month</u> program. The aim of this program is to encourage people to become writers by the act of simply writing. To achieve the NaNoWriMo goal of 50,000 words written in the 30 days of November, there are various groups, tools and apps designed to encourage people to give it a go. Since the group's founding in 1999, the community has grown to include a young writers' program and other initiatives.

Several books popular at our library began their lives as NaNoWriMo projects: Sara Gruen's *Water for Elephants*, Erin Morgenstern's *The Night Circus*, and Marissa Meyer's *Cinder*. In the collection are also a few books authored by local NaNoWriMo and "indie" authors including JJ Lair, Muriel Smith, Richard Barlaam, Melissa Campesi, Steve Kahofer, and yours truly. Of course, some local names may be familiar for their wider recognition: Kevin Coyne and Bruce Springsteen.

I am aware of several in our community working on writing projects; we look forward to adding their works to the library's collection someday. If you are interested in tackling a big project, consider November and NaNoWriMo. However, any writing is *still writing*, and your library is ready to support you with resources to read, research, and, quite possibly, an audience.
