

### Dear Library Patron

September is **Library Card Sign-Up Month**. Anyone who resides, works or attends school within the geographic bounds of Freehold Borough may have a free card. Folks not *not* in those categories probably have borrowing privileges with the Monmouth County Library System (headquarters is in Manalapan). Being a card-carrying member is not necessary to attend programs or use our facilities; however, we encourage everyone eligible to have a card. Annual nonresident memberships are available for \$25.00.





We are working with both Freehold High School and the Freehold Borough Elementary School District to ensure every student has their library card. No need to wait! Come into the library with proof of address and/or enrollment in Borough schools and get your young scholars their library card.

Just to mention Covid countermeasures: The library requires masking of all individuals over age 2 inside the building. As a precaution, all programs this month involving patrons younger than high school ages will continue to be planned for outdoors and are subject to weather cancellations. Please subscribe to
