SUSTAINABLE JERSEY - "A Better Tomorrow, One Community At A Time": All across New Jersey, hundreds of towns are now working on sustainability programs to help the environment, communities and their bottom lines. Efforts to curb carbon emissions, protect natural resources and reduce waste are happening at the local level. Through the voluntary program, communities are implementing re-use efforts like solar power, wind turbine project and rain capture. Freehold Borough achieved Sustainable Jersey Bronze Certification in 2019 and successfully achieved Bronze Recertification in 2022. The Boroughs' Green Team continues working to maintain the certification and implementing other initiatives. Looking at energy efficiency is another part of sustainability.

WINTER REMINDERS - SNOW ACCUMULATION AROUND FIRE HYDRANTS: New Jersey law requires the owner of a property which abuts a fire hydrant to **remove** any snow which may accumulate within **24 hours** of the snow coverage. Failure to remove the snow may result in a bill for snow removal service in an amount not to exceed \$75.00. Please note that the owner or tenant of a property bordering a sidewalk is responsible for the **removal** of all ice and snow within twelve **(12) hours** after it has accumulated.

HOME REPAIR ASSISTANCE: Freehold Borough's Housing Rehabilitation Program is currently accepting applications from qualified homeowners or investor/owners of rental properties who wish to make improvements to their property in order to meet Code compliance. Funds are available for existing units of residential properties, which are occupied by low and moderate-income persons. PET LICENSE OPTIONS NOTICE: At the Council Meeting on January 17th an Ordinance was introduced to provide **THREE-YEAR** Licenses for dogs and cats in Freehold Borough. The Ordinance is scheduled for Public Hearing and Adoption on February 13th. If passed, Freehold Borough residents will have the choice to register their dogs and/ cats for a ONE-YEAR or THREE-YEAR License. Renewal Notices with complete list of fees for both ONE-YEAR and **THREE-YEAR** Licenses will be sent in February after the February 13th Adoption. Licensing is currently

available for **ONE-YEAR ONLY** and can currently be obtained at Borough Hall.

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION will take place in the Borough during the months of April, July and October. The DPW site at 161 Center St. is open for brush collection on the first Saturday of the month from 7:00 a.m.- noon. **DOES NOT include LEAVES** which are able to be dropped off to the DPW site during November and December along with curbside pickup.
