

Feral Cats & Trap Neuter Release (TNR) Program

FEEDING OF WILD ANIMALS

- Feeding wild animals, including feral cats is prohibited, unless you are a registered Colony Caretaker with Freehold Borough.
- Any individual who is caring for non-owned or feral cats (providing food, water, shelter etc.) must register with Freehold Borough by contacting Lynn Cannon at Lcannon@freeholdboro.org



TNR PROGRAM

- Freehold Borough is testing a TNR program to control the number of stray cats.
- If you are caring for any feral or stray cats, or come across a new litter of kittens, please contact the Monmouth County SPCA TNR Coordinator to arrange for the cat/s to be spayed/neutered and vaccinated and returned to the colony for continued care.
