If you live in Freehold Borough in a home built before 1978, Neighborhood Connections to Health (NCTH) is offering FREE lead-testing kits for your home. Each kit contains 2 swabs, giving you the ability to test 2 surfaces in your home.

Please see the detailed kit instructions.

We recommend testing doorframes and window frames, as these are the highest friction areas and are likely to chip or wear away. Most importantly, if you see RED, that means there is LEAD. Feel free to give our team a call so we can assist you further – our numbers are listed on the back of the kit.

This program is provided by NCTH through a partnership between the VNA and the Freehold Area Health Department, and support provided by the Nicholson Foundation. For homes containing lead, we are able to provide some materials and cover some contractor costs to remediate and make your home lead-safe. This is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Don't wait! Be proactive in making homes safer for children.
